January 11, 2017 through February 9, 2017 (E-104 to E-75)	<p>Candidate Nomination Period Candidates must file nomination documents with the county election official during this period. <u>Optional</u> <i>Candidate Statements of Qualifications</i> and statement of officer sought to be recalled are due during this period. EC 11381, 10510, 13307, 11327</p>
January 16, 2017	County Office Closure
February 10, 2017 (E-74)	<p>Randomized Alphabet Drawing Conducted by the Secretary of State to determine candidate name order as it will appear on the ballot. EC 13113</p>
February 20, 2017	County Office Closure
March 16 – April 15 (E-40 to E-10)	<p>Sample Ballot Pamphlets Pamphlets are mailed to each registered voter during this time. EC 13300, 11324</p>
March 27 – April 18 (E-29 to E-7)	<p>Regular Vote by Mail Ballot Mailing and processing period for Vote by Mail ballots. Ballots will be available at the county elections office. EC 3001</p>
April 10 (E-15)	<p>15-Day Close Last day to register for this election. Postmarks, DMV, online registration and personal delivery to the election office are acceptable.</p>
April 11 – April 25 (E-14 to E)	<p>Conditional Registration Period For eligible persons who missed the 15 day close of registration, you may appear in person at the county election official's office and register to vote provisionally for this election. EC 2170</p>
April 19 – April 25 (E-6 to E)	<p>Special 7- day Ballots Available Available at the county election official's office for those voters unable to vote at the polls on election day. EC 3021</p>
April 25, 2017 (E)	<p>ELECTION DAY Polls are open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. EC 1000, 14212</p>
April 27 – May 25 (E+2 to E+30)	<p>Canvass of the Vote The official canvass of precinct returns shall commence and be completed during this time. The county election official shall prepare a certified statement of the results and submit it to the governing bodies involved with this election. EC 15301, 15372</p>
