1) 2024 Presidential General Election Key Dates:

- September 26, 2024 – County voter information guides begin mailing.
- October 7, 2024 – Vote by mail ballots mailing begin. Ballot drop boxes will be available.
- October 21, 2024 – Last day to register to vote. Individuals not registered by this date, would need visit a vote center or our office.
- October 26, 2024 – 6 vote centers will be open through the weekends and Election Day.
- November 2, 2024 – 26 more vote centers open through the weekend and Election Day.
- November 4, 2024 – 1 additional vote center opens in Patterson through Election Day.
- November 5, 2024 – Election Day

Business hours of voting locations will be available in the county voter guide, direct postcard mailing and stanvote.gov

PART-TIME ELECTION CLERK

Starting pay is \$18.52 per hour.

Typical tasks include:

- Register and update voter registration using a laptop
- Provide professional and accurate customer service
- Set up and assist voters with voting equipment
- May also work in the Elections Office.

VOLUNTEER

Daily stipend \$150 per early voting day and \$235 for Election Day.

Typical tasks include:

- Greet voters and manage lines
- Take down voting equipment
- Assist voters with voting equipment
- Accept ballots at curbside ballot drop-off locations
