QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT / SANITARY DISTRICT / MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL: Must be a registered voter residing within the boundaries of the district and must not be a compensated employee of the district. Gov Code 61040

FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT: Must be a registered voter and a resident of the district and must not be a compensated employee of the district. Health & Safety Code 13841; Gov Code 53227

IRRIGATION DISTRICT: Shall be a registered voter and a landowner of the district and a resident of the division which he/she represents at the time of his/her nomination and during his/her entire term. For exceptions to the landowner requirement, see full text of Water Code 21100.

SCHOOL DISTRICT: Shall be a registered voter of the district; in the case of trustee areas, shall be a resident of the trustee area which he/she represents. An employee of a school district may not be sworn into office as an elected or appointed member of that school district's governing body unless and until he or she resigns as an employee. Ed Code 5030 and 35107. Any registered voter is eligible to be a member of the county board of education except the county superintendent of schools, any member of his/her staff or any employee of the school district. Ed Code 1006

Declaration of Candidacy forms will be available and must be filed beginning Monday, July 13, 2020, through Friday, August 7, 2020, by 5:00 p.m. at the office of the Stanislaus County Registrar of Voters, located at 1021 "I" Street, Suite 101, Modesto, California. If an eligible incumbent does not file during this period, there will be an extension of the nomination period for that specific office until Wednesday, August 12, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. for anyone other than the incumbent. Due to COVID-19 precautions, candidate filing will be by appointment only. Appointment scheduling begins on July 1 by calling 209-525-5201. For information regarding filing for elective office call: 209-525-5201.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that appointment to each elective office will be made in the event there are no nominees or an insufficient number of nominees for such office and a petition for an election is not filed within the time period prescribed by law. (Appointments will be made pursuant to 10515 of the Elections Code or 5326, 5328 and 5328.5 of the Education Code.)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Executive Order N-64-20 and N-67-20 issued by Governor Gavin Newsom, all Californians who are registered (and otherwise eligible) to vote in the November 3, 2020 General Election shall receive vote-by-mail ballots. Satellite offices and secure ballot drop boxes will be available throughout the county. Satellite offices are designed to assist voters with accessibility and language needs or to obtain a replacement vote-by-mail ballot. Locations will be listed in the county voter information guide and posted on www.stanvote.com. Satellite offices will be open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturday, October 31, 2020, through Monday, November 2, 2020. The county elections office and satellite offices will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that ballots from the November 3, 2020 General Election are to be tallied and the canvass of the vote will be conducted at the Stanislaus County Registrar of Voters Office (central counting place) at 1021 "I" Street, Suite 101, Modesto, California, commencing no later than 9:00 a.m. November 5, 2020.
